

Student Vehicle Policy and Registration

Please be reminded that school policy <u>does not</u> permit student drivers to drive other students to school-sponsored activities during or after school hours if the trip originates from the school. Students may drive themselves to school-sponsored activities with a prior permission/waiver release form from their parents which are to be turned in to the office before the student leaves the school premises.

Specific to athletic transportation, please adhere to the following:

- Students must be transported to school-sponsored sporting events either by school approved drivers or their parents.
- Parent drivers must have a volunteer driver form completed and on file in the school office. Volunteer
 driver forms are available in the school office and on the school website.

If your son/daughter drives a vehicle to school it must be registered with the school office and must comply with the student driver policy:

Students are not allowed to:

Drive off campus during school hours (8:00 a.m. – 3:05 p.m.)

Be in or by vehicles during school hours

Transport any other student in their vehicle without the completed waiver permission from both parties' parents.

Student parking is along the north side of the building, **not in front of the dumpster**. Students must have a valid Oregon driver's license.

WVCS administration reserves the right to revoke student driving privileges when students do not comply with the WVCS Student Driver Policy.
